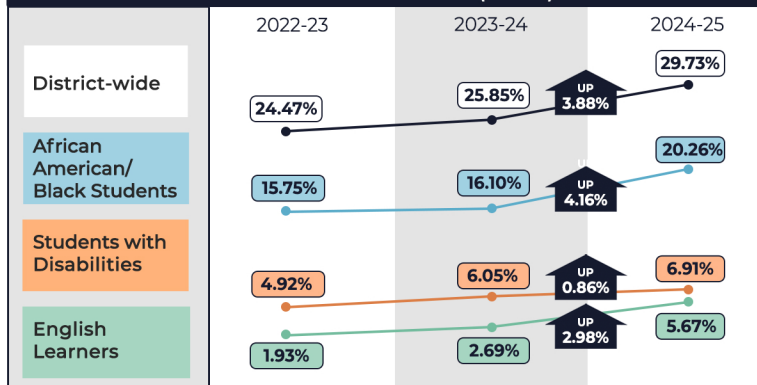

### K-2: Progress Made Towards Grade Level (SIPPS)

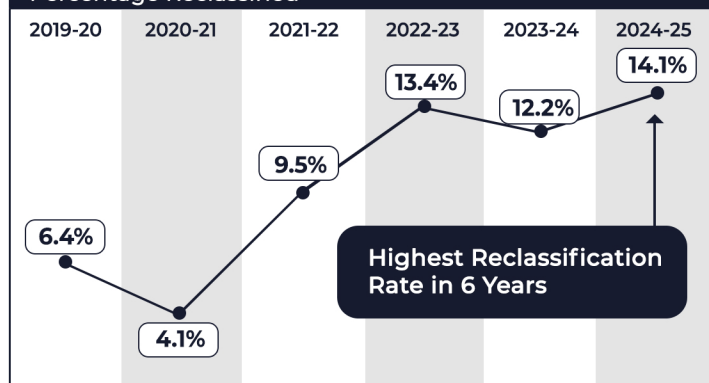
